I'm sick and I'm tired of reading about, watching commentary, and listening about Covid-19. It's been beaten into us and regardless of beliefs, most of us have come to accept that this is a reality. The pervasive nature of this virus is far reaching & is impacting every little nuance of our global society, right down to our ski club. I am pleased to report that at this time, the club Board has chosen to pursue our Midwest trips as we have in the past. However, it is with member safety in mind, that we will not be providing food and beverages any longer. This will become an individual member responsibility until further notice. This means you will have to pack your own snacks and beverages for your chosen trips. We are working with the transportation and lodging providers to follow the recommended CDC guidelines, at that time. Specific details on such protocols will be provided as we approach trip departure dates.

Now for some good news we can use! Midwest trips have been set, with full details in upcoming issues. Our midweek trips were a success last year and are back for another year heading to Ski Brule, Marquette Mountain, and Big PowderHorn. We will also be hosting a weekend trip to Houghton, Michigan skiing Mt. Ripley or Mt. Bohemia (skiers select choice with registration) on Saturday and The Porkies on Sunday. In case this is the first newsletter you have read in many months, our Western trip destination is Big Sky, Montana in March! Collectively, this packed schedule has a trip running nearly every other week, with the opportunity to ski 15 days! Make sure to read upcoming issues for full details on each trip.

Speaking of travels, I want to remind everyone about Passports, and Real ID's. The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) has new identification requirements beginning October 1, 2021. In order to fly or enter Federal Government Facilities you must present a special license called a REAL ID, or present a passport or other similar proof of identity in conjunction with your ID. Obtaining the REAL ID is done through the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV). This is your choice to get it, however suggest you consider getting it, as it will make your life easier so you're not left at a check-in point, without the proper identification. REAL ID does not replace your passport which you will need for foreign travels. In the interim, for those traveling with Sly Fox to Europe this coming season, make sure to check your passport, to ensure it is current and won't expire before/during your trip! I do not know for certain, however would not be surprised, if the processing of REAL ID and Passports are delayed as a result of Covid. Don't wait until the last minute and be left behind! Look into getting these documents updated for hassle free travels both with or without the ski club.

Ok, I have done my job for today! It's time to go relax with a beverage and have positive thoughts of a Covid free ski season.

## **Big Sky, March 13-20, 2021**

I will be your trip leader to Big Sky on March 13 next year. Claudia Elsner has agreed to be the assistant leader for the trip. COVID-19 has caused some delays to our typical schedule for trip planning but our western trip committee will be working out final details over the next few weeks. The trip sign-up form will be in the September newsletter.

Big Sky is a world-class mountain with 5,850 skiable acres receiving an average of 400 inches of snow per year. The mountain has excellent terrain for every level of skier and a great lift system. We have been targeting a return to Big Sky for several years. You will not want to miss the opportunity to ski in one of the most beautiful parts of the country.

The planning for our trip to Big Sky Montana on March 13 is in full swing after receiving quotes for airfare last week with Delta and United out of Milwaukee. Although we have not set the final price for the trip, we expect the trip cost will be \$1,745 or less for the base package. There is hope that airfare will be reduced over the coming weeks or months that would result in savings for all of us.

**The trip will open for sign-up on October 2.** The base package will include airfare, ski in/ski out from the Big Horn Condominiums using a Poma lift, the shuttle to Big Sky and a 5 of 6-day lift ticket at Big Sky. The trip will also include a welcome reception hosted by Big Sky, an après ski gathering, and the departure dinner Friday evening.

The current price for the trip also includes an estimate for either bussing or a stay & fly hotel stay near General Mitchell Airport. The stay & fly option includes a night at the hotel and car parking. At this point, we are leaning towards using the stay & fly option because it offers advantages versus bussing. Both flights are morning flights and the stay & fly option would help avoid a midnight bus pick-up. One option for this trip is to stay at first class hotel, The Huntley Lodge, at the base of the lifts. We reserved five rooms at an additional cost of \$390 ea. This option includes a full breakfast every day.

We are also checking into the feasibility of a day trip to Bridger Bowl. Bridger Bowl is an area near Bozeman with great reviews. We will have a cost estimate for this trip fairly soon and we will include the option if it is feasible.

Again, look for our sign-up form in the September Newsletter. We will have an updated trip cost with available options listed, along with other vacation information.

**Trip is open for signup on June 8, 2020.** Initial deposit of \$600 required. Second payment of \$900 is due September 7, 2020. Final balance is due November 18, 2020. Cancellation fees are as follows:

While cancellation fees can be waived if a substitute can be found for the spot, there will be a minimum \$100 cancellation fee plus any costs associated with the change. After airline tickets are issued on December 15, they are non refundable less and non-changeable (no name changes allowed).

This trip has been priced at an exchange rate of 1.00 Euro = \$1.12US. While there is a contingency allowance built in to the trip, any extreme change in the rates could increase the cost of the trip which is the responsibility of the trip participants. If the exchange rate turns in our favor, added benefits will be included (parties, transport tickets, activities, etc).

Adequate insurance in case of accidents, skier mountain evacuation, emergency medical treatment, and evacuation home, are recommended. See Insurance Page for offer from Travel Protectors for Medevac, Full Trip, and Cancel for Any Reason plans.

A valid passport is required, and should have an expiration date no earlier than August 3, 2021 (6 months validity beyond the trip completion date).

Due to the extra airline fees required for luggage of more than one checked item, and bus storage limitations, I STRONGLY recommend that you rent skis in Meribel and leave yours at home.

Membership in the Sly Fox Ski Club or the Gelandesprung Ski Club is a requirement to sign up.

## Group Travel Insurance

Travel Protectors, LLC is offering the club group rates for our trip to France and Barcelona!

#### **Option One: Basic Travel Insurance for \$25.00 per person. Included benefits per person are:**

- Primary medical coverage - \$50K per person.
- Medical evacuation and repatriation - \$250K per person.
- Trip Delay – For lodging and meals if you are delayed more than six hours due to inclement weather. Up to max \$750 (\$150/day) . per person.
- Missed Connection – if your first flight is delayed more than three hours and you miss your connecting flight. (You can buy a new airline ticket to reach your final destination. Maximum \$500 per person).
- Baggage delay \$400 per person – must be more than 24 hours before you can use this benefit.
- Limited Trip Interruption – Limited up to \$500 per person towards airfare for return flight only. (You will not be reimbursed for any loss of your trip cost, a higher airfare collection over \$500 per person or for additional lodging and meals if you have to remain behind due to an accident or illness).

**(Trip Cancellation and Full Trip Interruption Coverage not included unless you purchase option one or two described below).**

#### **Option Two: Trip Cancellation and Full Trip Interruption Coverage – Will not insure against pandemic, epidemics or outbreaks of any kind!**

#### **Below are the reasons you can cancel your trip and receive a 100% refund.**

1. Your trip cost is fully refundable if you cancel before you leave home.
2. If you had to suddenly and unexpectedly interrupt your trip due to you being ill, or injured, or an immediate family member is taken ill or injured or passes away, you will be reimbursed for the portion of the trip you miss and for a change of airfare up to a maximum of 150% of your trip cost.
3. If your traveling companion is ill, injured or passes away before your departure from home but you still want to continue on the trip, you will be reimbursed if charged a single supplement.
4. If your traveling companion is ill or injured but you are not and you no longer want to go on the trip, you can file a claim for a full reimbursement of trip cost.

5. If you are injured or ill while traveling and must to extend your stay, unexpectedly, the travel insurance reimburses you for your extended meals, lodging and transportation.
6. If you are already working and asked to cancel your trip due to work reasons, you can file a claim and be reimbursed provided the vacation time had already been approved.
7. If inclement weather makes your home uninhabitable or your destination unreachable, you can also cancel and get full a refund!

**Option Three: \*\*Cancel for Any Reason aka CFAR.**

\*\*\*Cancel for any Reason allows you to cancel your trip for any reason whether it is a standard reason like illness, injury or death or due to fear of a pandemic/epidemic or fear of war or civil unrest or simply because you have a pet and you want to be available if the pet is sick. (It does not apply if you must interrupt your trip to return home).

**It is a strict policy!**

1. You must purchase it **within 14 days of your very first trip deposit.** Either the date on your check is considered day one or if you paid by credit/debit or Pay Pal, the transaction date is considered day one.
2. You **must notify the travel insurance company at least 48 hours prior to your departure date** if you are cancelling the trip. Cancelling less than 48 hours results in no refund.
3. If you cancel for a non-standard reason, **you will be refunded 75% of your trip cost not 100%. I**
4. IF YOU CANCEL FOR A STANDARD REASON; ILLNESS, INJURY OR DEATH TO YOU, YOUR TRAVELING COMPANION/S OR IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBER **YOU WILL RECEIVE A 100% REFUND!**
