Big Sky Montana-September Update.

When: January 29, 2022 to February 5, 2022.

Sing-up Date: The trip will **open for sign-up on October 1, 2021** at Gelandesprung's Fall Banquet and through the US Mail.

First Rights:

- Gelandesprung and Sly Fox Ski clubs are using similar approaches to be fair to people that had previously signed up for our cancelled western trips.
- **Everyone can sign up beginning October 1.**
- **Those that signed up last year have first rights to the trip as long as they sign up between 10/1 - 10/14.** All other sign ups will be handled as always - first come first served.

Sign-up Form:

The sign-up form will appear in the in the **October issue of the Gelandesprung Gazette**. The sign-up form will also be placed on the **Gelandesprung Web Page as soon as it as feasible**. This is likely to be from September 20, to September 26. Airline booking is the reason for the delay.

Final airline information is expected September 16, hopefully with lower cost. Departure from Chicago or Milwaukee is the most likely scenario.

At present, we have 12 condos rented for 72 people and two rooms in the Huntley Lodge for four people. I will be asking for additional rooms at the Huntley Lodge based upon interest expressed to me via email.

The base price for the trip will be approximately \$2,000. This price includes transportation to and from Big Sky, Condo lodging, a 5-day pass, our happy hour, and departure dinner. The increase from this year is due to substantially higher prices for airlines, lift tickets and lodging. The Huntley Lodge is \$450 more than the condos.

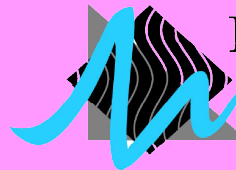

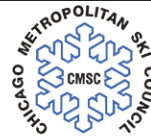
