On Tuesday February 14th, we will have a pre-trip meeting at the Woods for our Midwest trip to Hastings, Minnesota. Minnesota has had several inches of natural snow this season and more is expected. Skiing should be good. Currently we have 28 skiers signed up. Frank Wickham is the trip leader (920-217-1643) and Scot Wederquist is the assistant trip leader (608-575-1788).

The bus will load at the Bar in Appleton at 1:30 pm on Monday, February 20th and depart Appleton at 2 pm sharp. The bus will pick up the remainder of the group at the Woods at 2:30 pm (parking at the Woods should be along the fence by the houses on the golf side of the parking lot) and depart promptly at 3:00 pm. We are planning to drive directly to Hastings to arrive at approximately 7:15 pm. **Be sure to bring any snacks or beverages you may want to consume with you on the bus.**

For those of you planning to enjoy cross-country skiing we will provide transportation to Afton State Park on Tuesday February 21st when the downhill skiers are skiing Afton Alps. On Wednesday February 22nd, you will be able to ski St Croix Regional Park on the day the group is skiing Welch Village.

On Tuesday February 21st all will board the bus at Nichols Inn and take a short trip to Afton Alps and Afton State Park. That evening the bus will return all skiers to the Nichols Inn.

Wednesday February 22nd, you will check out of the Inn and board the bus with your luggage and ski gear. The bus will drop the downhill skiers off at Welch Village and the cross-country skiers will proceed to St Croix Regional Park for a day of skiing. End of day Wednesday, February 22nd, we all board the bus and head home.

Midwest ski trip to Hastings Minnesota

Our Midwest Trip for this year is a new destination. This year we are skiing both Afton Alps and Welch Village. These two resorts are both located equal distance from Hastings, Minnesota in the St Croix River Valley. We will travel to Hastings the afternoon of February 20th and stay at Nichols Inn and Suites. The evening meal will be on your own. A short walk from the hotel is Las Margaritas Mexican Restaurant, Applebees, and The Bar Draft House serving craft beer and Heggies Pizza (whatever that is?). The next morning breakfast is included in our stay at the Nichols Inn. They specialize in fresh omelets and homemade waffles. After a hearty breakfast we board the bus for a 15-minute trip to Afton Alps. Afton Alps has six dining options for your mid-day break. After skiing and an appropriate amount of time for après ski, we will board the bus and head back to the hotel where you can relax in the hot tub or swimming pool before venturing out for your evening meal.

The next morning, we again enjoy a hearty breakfast and board the bus for a 15-minute trip in the opposite direction to Welch Village. We will check out of the hotel and load all our gear on the bus for our trip south to Welch Village. Welch Village is one of the last family operated resorts in the US. Dining at Welch Village is unfortunately limited. They have only two venues for food so we will be making an early stop for food that evening after we board the bus for home.

We have the opportunity to include two options for cross country skiers or snowshoe enthusiasts. Afton Alps is located adjacent to Afton State Park. The park has 12 miles of cross-country ski trails with a 2.5-mile loop for beginners. Snow shoe rentals are available at the park office. The park is cut by deep ravines which drop 300 feet to the river. The ravines display spectacular outcrops of sandstone and the rugged terrain affords spectacular views of the St. Croix River Valley. The park is set in a rolling glacial moraine and bluffland. It contains a combination of oak openings and woodlands. The forests combine upland hardwoods with some pine plantations. Remnant prairies are being expanded and oak savannas are being restored through an aggressive resource management program that makes extensive use of volunteers. Park wildflowers include prairie pasque flowers and woodland ephemerals in the spring; butterfly weed and puccoons on the summer prairie; and sunflowers and blazing star in the fall.

Another option for cross country skiing is Cannon Valley Trail or St Croix Bluffs Regional Park. The Cannon Valley Trail is A 20-mile paved recreational rail trail between Cannon Falls and Red Wing for biking, hiking, in-line skating and cross-country skiing. The trail closely follows the Cannon River, winding through a varied landscape of bluffs, valleys, prairies, forests, marshland & farmland. St. Croix Bluffs Regional Park is a 579-acre Regional Park located on the wild and scenic St. Croix River. The park offers a variety of landscape types including rolling upland hills, wooded ravines, and 3/4 mile of river frontage. This area offers 6.5 miles of groomed trails with both traditional and skate trails available. Daily transportation will be arranged based upon level of interest.

This will be a fun new destination for us. Two years of Covid restrictions have generated a pent-up demand for ski trips so sign up early. This trip is limited to 40 skiers.

Welch Village

Welch Village sits in the densely wooded scenic Cannon River Valley and has been family-owned since 1965. It offers a nice variety of 60 trails spread out over 140 acres of skiable terrain that cater to all skiing and snowboarding levels, and a quartet of black-diamond, front-face runs that are among the steepest in the region. Two nicely spaced day lodges along the bottom of the sprawling ski hill offer lots of eating and lounging choices. The summit is at 1,060 feet with a 360-foot vertical drop. They have three quad chairs, one triple and four doubles serving 125 acres of skiable terrain.

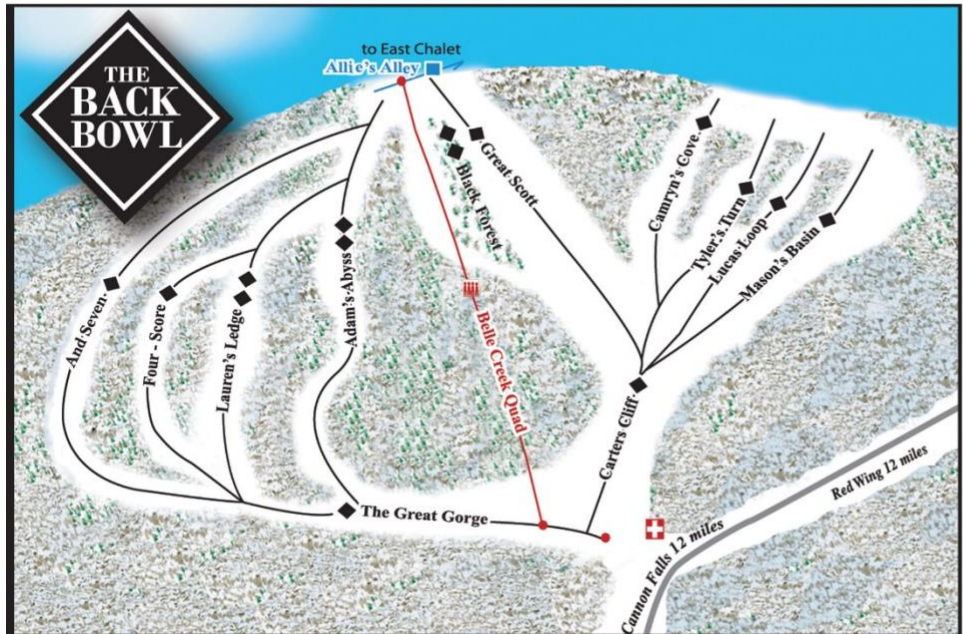

GELANDESPRUNG Ski Club is going to **Afton Alps and Welch Village for a two night stay**. The bus leaves Monday afternoon February 20th and will return Wednesday, February 22nd after skiing. The trip includes lift tickets, travel in the comfort of a Lamer's Deluxe Motor Coach, two nights lodging in Hastings MN at the Nicholls Inn & Suites and breakfast each day. Sign-up Starts on October 7th at the Fall Banquet. This is a new destination for the club and is destined to be a favorite for years to come. Afton Alps boasts 16 chair lifts servicing 37 trails. Welch village has 8 chair lifts servicing 50 runs and 140 acres of skiable terrain. The trip also offers an excellent opportunity for cross country and shoeshoe enthusiasts, Afton State Park and St Croix Bluffs Regional Park offer groomed trails as well as challenging snow shoe opportunities. A Credit of \$88 dollars will be given to those opting out of lift tickets.

- Aiding a person injured while skiing by making sure he or she is okay and that family and friends are notified.

- Helping out during ski trips, luggage, events, etc.
- A person using their exceptional skill set to help the club deal with issues. Examples include information technology, communication, and similar tasks.
- A board member for straightening out a major problem within their area of responsibility, above and beyond what would be expected for the normal workload.



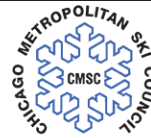
